2. **Volunteer at the polls**

Sign up to work a shift at your preferred early voting site on the first and second days of early voting (February 12 and 13), as well as on the weekends (February 14, 15, 21, and 22). We also need volunteers on Election Day. Even a few hours on any single day makes a real difference. Voters notice visible support at the polls, and your presence helps ensure people have the information they need and feel confident participating in this election. 3. **Volunteer with voter outreach**

4. **Vote (the most important step)**

The easiest and most impactful way you can help is to show up and cast your ballot. Early voting begins on Thursday, February 12th at [12 locations throughout Wake County](#).

All sites have the same hours of operation. Weekdays from 8:00am to 7:30pm, Saturdays from 8:00am to 3:00pm and Sundays from 1:00pm to 6:00pm.
